#### Children

- 2. I will do my best to eat healthily and exercise.
- 3. I will prepare myself for school and bring everything I need.

### The School will

- 1. Provide a high standard of education for all pupils.
- 2. Provide a happy, safe and secure environment where effective learning can take place.
- 3. Act promptly to deal with bullying, sexist, racist, homophobic, negative and anti-social behaviour.

- 4. Provide information which will help parents to support their children's learning effectively.
- 5. Inform parents about their children's progress across the year through meetings or written reports.
- 6. Help all children to reach their full potential.

# As Parent(s)/Carer(s) I/we will

- 1. Ensure my child arrives at school on time, if possible on foot, and is properly equipped (e.g. In KS2 a pencil case, healthy packed lunch if required, coat, PE kit).
- 2. Ensure that all absences are accounted for and that the school is informed.
- 3. Encourage my child to follow the school's code of conduct.
- 4. Encourage and support my child to do their homework as requested.
- 5. Do what I can to support the life and ethos of the school.
- 6. Ensure that my child is collected promptly at the end of the school day.

#### Together as School/Parents we will

- 1. Keep one another informed of events at school or at home which might affect our children's learning.
- 2. Encourage our children to do their best in their school work.
- 3. Encourage our children to respect one another and their environment.
