### Who is your favourite?

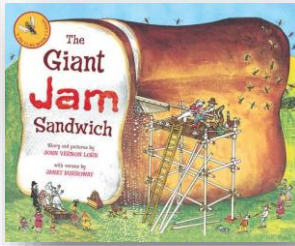
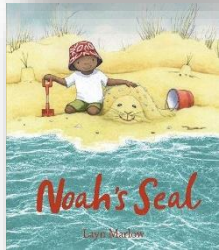
