Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know in November we launched our 'Step It Up' initiative in November with the opening of our new track and introduction of pedometers in Years 2 to 6. It has certainly rejuvenated the children's and staff's enthusiasm for the Daily Mile run/jog but unfortunately the pedometers have been a disappointing hassle.

As we were purchasing 300 pedometers on a budget we did not receive the quality of pedometer we hoped would really engage everyone in 'stepping it up'. Many of the pedometers broke in the first couple of weeks, and although they have been replaced by the company this is already happening again. In addition, many were not looked after as they should have been and as a result have been lost.

We are very passionate about our 'Step It Up' initiative; running weekly challenges and classes competing against each other whilst improving their fitness. Therefore, we are asking that during the holidays you purchase a pedometer for your child. It does not have to be an expensive one but as you are buying only one or two hopefully you will be able to spend a little more. We also hope that the children will look after them more carefully as you have bought them. We cannot recommend any specific ones as we have not tried them but Amazon have a wide selection at reasonable prices. For example:
