Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Kit

Please may I remind you that all children should bring the following sports kit to school to wear for PE:

- House Colour PE T-shirt (available to buy on Parentmail from the school)
- Black/Navy plain shorts or Black/Navy plain leggings or tracksuit bottoms (winter)
- Plain black/navy/dark grey sports sweatshirt no hoods and no branding please (winter)
- Plimsolls or plain trainers

Children without their PE kit will not be allowed to participate in the active part of the PE lesson but will be given a written PE task to complete.

Mobile Phones in School

In keeping with a number of local secondary schools we have decided that from September onwards, **smart phones should not be brought into school by children under any circumstances**. If children need mobile phones to contact their parents when walking to and from school, we suggest that you purchase a simple pay-as-you-go 'brick' phone (ideally with no camera) for this purpose.

On arrival at school, phones should be handed in to the class teacher and they will be returned at the end of the school day. Mobile phones may not be used by children anywhere on the school premises, therefore they may not be used in the school playground, in Breakfast Club, in After School Club or in one of the Activity Clubs which are organised through the school.

If your child needs to contact you, or you need to contact your child, at any time when they are in the school building, the office staff will be happy to help.

Trim Trail

For safety reasons all children (pupils and their younger siblings) should not use the trim trail before or after school.

Scooters and Bikes

As soon as children reach the school gate they should push their bike or scooter to the bike/scooter park, to ensure that the playground is a safe place for everyone. Please remember to take bikes and scooters home at the end of each day. We recommend that bikes and scooters are locked to the bars in the bike/scooter park.

Parents/Carers - Do you enjoy singing?

As some of you may know, the adult choir we have at school (Trinity Singers) has been successfully up and running for the past five years. We sing a wide variety of fantastic songs for fun and at various events (Carol Service/Summer Fair) and we've even been lucky enough to sing at the Royal Albert Hall twice!
