- ✓ we are growing together as **children of God**, strengthening our faith, secure in the knowledge we are unique, loved and cherished.


Dear Parents and Carers

As part of their sculpture unit in Art, Year 4 has been creating sculptures with wire. It proved to be fiddly and tricky; new skills were learnt, patience was tested, but the results were incredible!

Smartphone Free Policy

I thought it would be wise to share again our policy for our children. Children are not allowed to bring Smartphones or Smartwatches into school. The only phones allowed are of the 'brick' type, or those which cannot access the internet (Jennifer Powers shared a number of alternatives with us). The only children who might wish to bring a phone into school are those in Year 5 and 6 who walk to and from school unaccompanied. All phones are handed in to the class teacher on arrival in school, and are handed out at the end of the day.


