What is the drop off procedure?	The Faraday Gate will open at 8.30 each day, when a member of staff will be on duty.
	The official start of the day for Reception to Year 6 is 8.45. It is expected that all children will be in school from this time. Nursery starts at 8.30.
	At drop off we are asking all families (except nursery) to enter the playground via the Faraday Road Gate , and exit the playground via the Effra Road Gate . The one-way system that has been in place will continue to operate.
	There will be labelled signs and cones for children to line up at. As soon as your child has gone to their cone we ask that you vacate the playground as soon as possible, leaving via the Effra Road gate. This helped the children to settle in so smoothly last year.
