As part of South Heritage Month and their RE learning about What Makes Something Special - Special Places (Places of Worship), Nursery recently went to visit the Temple on Effra Road.



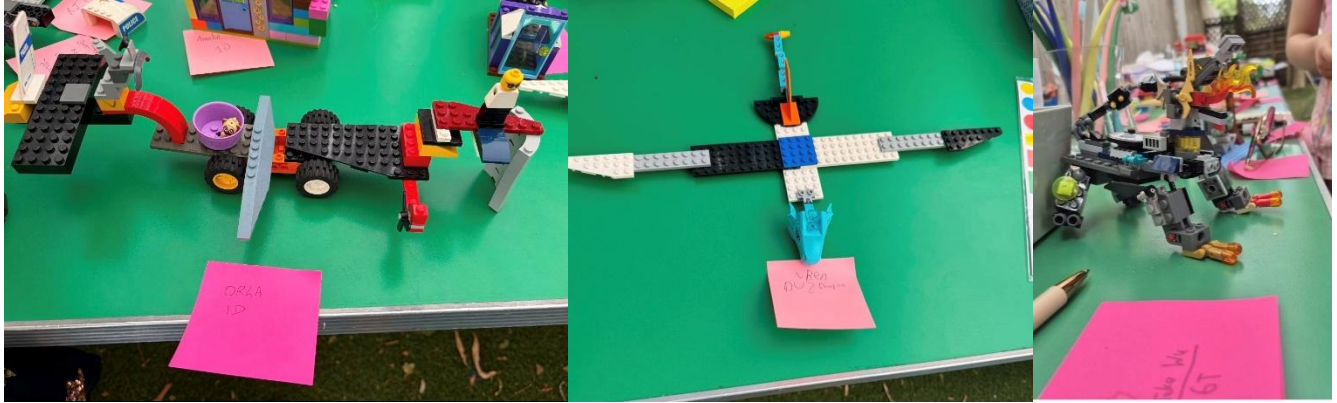

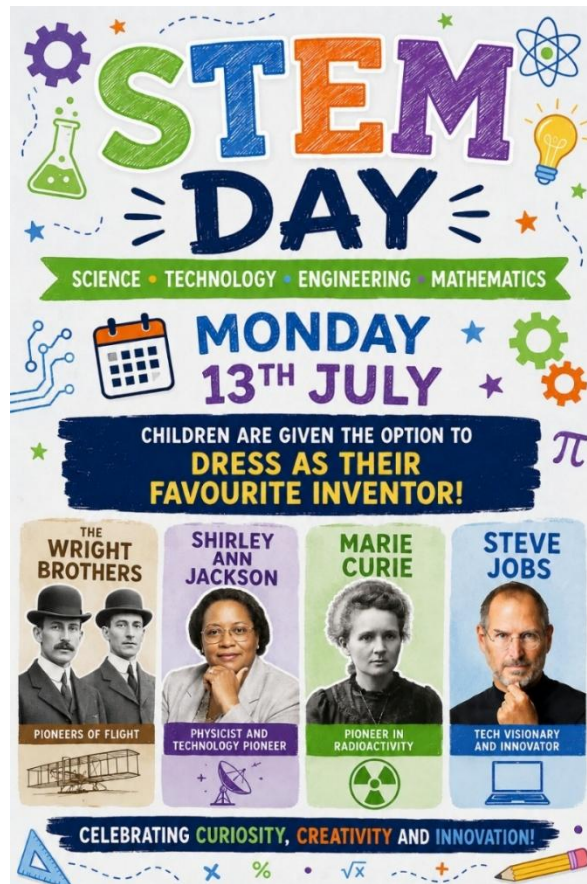

Extended Share My Learning – Friday 17th July 2026

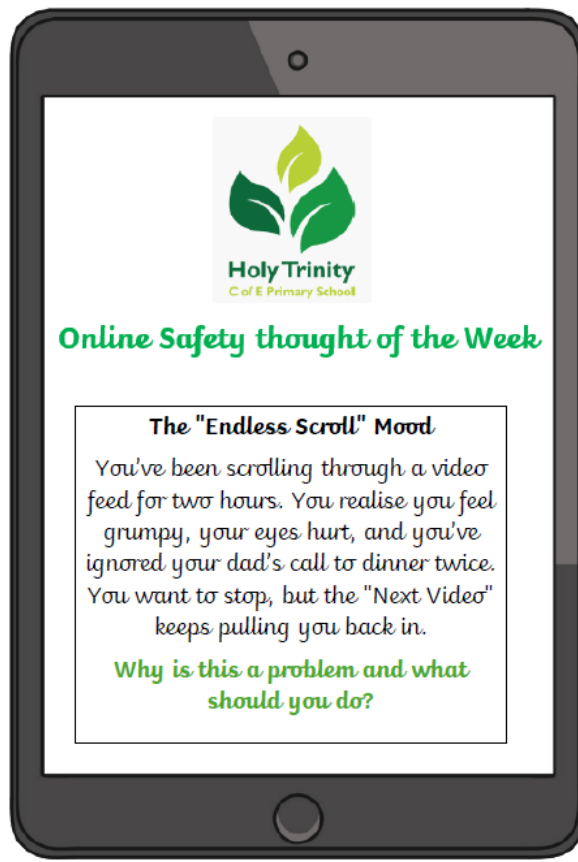
