Local Incidents

Many of you will be aware of the recent muggings and attempted muggings in the local area, particularly around South Park Gardens. Our Year 6 children have had a very useful workshop on safety this week, but I would urge you to also talk to your children about keeping their mobile phones, and headphones, out of sight when they are walking to and from school. Please do take care and be extra vigilant.

Mobile Phones

Please may I remind you that only those children who walk to and from school unaccompanied should be bringing mobile phones into school. Mobile phones should be simple, 'brick' type phones, and not smartphones. If a child, without a phone, needs to make an urgent phone call home, we are more than happy to do this for them.

Emergency Contacts

If there are any changes to your emergency contacts, please ensure you let the school office know immediately. If your Year 5 or 6 child does have a mobile phone, it may be wise to ensure that your emergency contacts have their phone number too.
