### **Clothing Labels**

Please take some time over the weekend to ensure that all items, including shoes, are clearly labelled with the correct child's first name and surname (not just a surname and not the name of a sibling who has now left the school!). If the uniform is second hand, please ensure that the original child's name is no longer visible. If the labelling has been done in pen, please check that the writing has not faded. Any named lost property is being returned to the appropriate class immediately - our staff and prefects can only reunite items with their owners if the name on the label matches a name on our current student list.

# Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

Might you be eligible for Free School Meals or Pupil Premium? You may not know, but in addition to getting hot meals free of charge, the school also gets an amount of money to support your child at school. In the past this money has been used to help fund interventions, books, school trips, residential trips and activity clubs.
