Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been assessment week this week – we are so proud of all of the children for their excellent attitude to learning. Despite it being assessment week, the children have managed to pack in so much. Read on to find out what the children have been up to.

Reception visited Wimbledon Fire Station as part of their *People in the Community* topic. They all had a go at squirting water using the hose!



Year I had a Christopher Columbus workshop this week which they really enjoyed. They played lots of games and drama activities to learn more about the great explorer.

Year 2 have been designing and building houses from 1666 to create their very own Pudding Lane, where the Great Fire of London started.



In Art, Year 3 have created scenes with winter trees inspired by the book *Ice Palace*. They had to consider how they would show their trees in the distance, how they would make them unique and how they would use line to show shape and texture.



Following assessments, Year 5 have been Maths detectives by investigating abundant, deficient and perfect numbers using their knowledge of multiples and factors.

Year 6 enjoyed creating a piece of art to depict what 'difference' means to them, in line with their PSHE theme and class text Wonder.



In Computing;) Year 6 have been learning about online safety, thinking about how to stay safe online, what are the dangers online, as well as positives of online apps. We've used the saying 'SMART' which stands for Safe, Meet, Accepting, Reliable and Tell. We've also learnt about how to report concerns online through CEOPS.

School Admissions Arrangements - draft policy for consultation 18 November 2019 to 12 January 2020

As a Voluntary-Aided Church of England school, Holy Trinity school in Wimbledon is the admissions authority responsible for setting admissions arrangements annually for both the nursery and school places. Every seven years, in accordance with the Schools Admissions Code 2014, we must consult on these arrangements.

This year we have made some suggested minor amendments to the policy in line with other schools within Merton or Southwark Diocese which are highlighted in yellow in the draft policy so it is easier for you to determine the changes from our current Admissions Policy published on our website (dated March 2019 for admissions from September 2020). Namely amends relate to:

- Children of staff children of permanent staff will be on our priority list (to help with staff recruitment and
- Siblings (Open places priority will be given to siblings who applied as an open place)
- Tiebreaker (in instances where two or more applicants have equal priority for final places)
- Nursery places (clarifying full and part time places available)
- Waiting lists (Year 2 and above will operate as one list)

The proposed draft policy (which can be found on our website

https://www.holytrinity.merton.sch.uk/web/admissions/308143) will take effect for entry into nursery and reception from 2021 and be ratified at a full Governing Body meeting after the consultation period ends on 12 January. The new policy will be published on our website by 15 March 2020.
