Parent Teacher Consultations

Share My Learning - Friday 13th October, 8.15-8.45am

Share My Learning sessions are an opportunity for children to show their parents/carers their work and their classroom.

The Share My Learning session this half-term will be held on **Friday 13**th **October**. The sessions are suited to parents/carers of children in Reception through to Year 6. It can sometimes be too unsettling for the nursery children at this stage in the year when it comes to parents leaving after the session.

If you arrive between 8.15 and 8.30am, please enter via the main front door on Effra Road. After this time, enter via the Faraday Gate from the playground. We will ask parents to vacate the building at 8.45am so that we can start the school day promptly.

If you are a key worker, and unable to come in and see your child's work, do email <u>headteacher@holytrinity.merton.sch.uk</u> and I will work out a way for you to see the books.

Morning Drop and Go!

Please continue to drop your children (Years 1-6) and then vacate the playground as soon as possible please – this really does help the children settle quicker.

Pokémon Cards

Please ensure that no Pokémon, or other trading cards, are brought into school. They are a distraction and can easily get lost. Thank you.

No Nuts

This is just a reminder that we are a no nut school. Please ensure that packed lunches and snacks do not contain any nuts at all – this includes Nutella in sandwiches. Thank you for your support with this.

Punctuality

This is just a reminder that pupils (Reception to Year 6) should be in school by 8.45am, and should enter via the Faraday Gate. We are seeing a number of children arriving after this time, and coming through the Effra Gate, or the main school office. Early work takes place in class as soon as children arrive in school, children who are late are missing this valuable learning time.

Please do not enter school via the back door from the playground, but instead come around to the main school office where you can be signed in. Thank you so much for your support.


If numbers are your thing, perhaps you are an accountant or just numerically inclined, then this could be the role for you!


