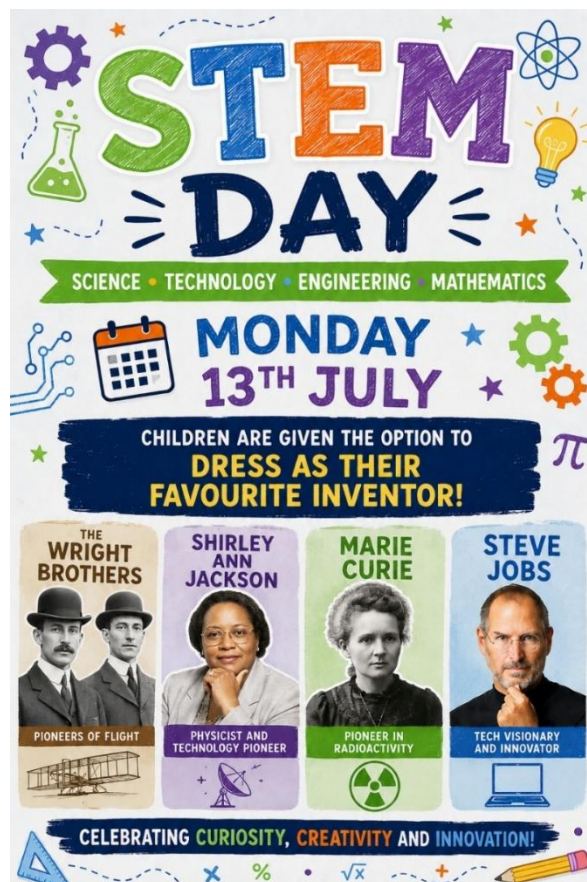
Annual Holy Trinity House Music Festival Wednesday 15th July 9:45am in the school hall

We are looking for children and young people who have a passion for theatre to collaborate with us to create the best children's shows and have a say in how Polka is run.

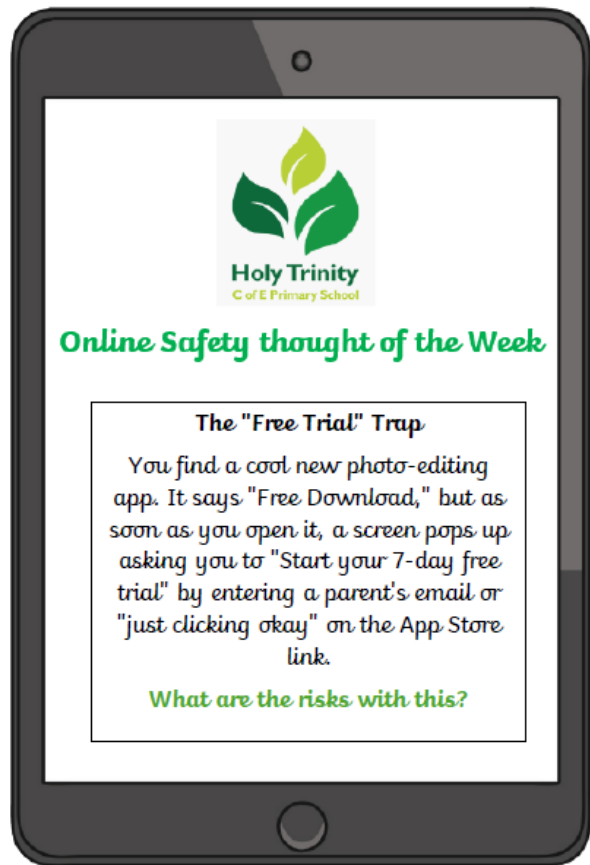
